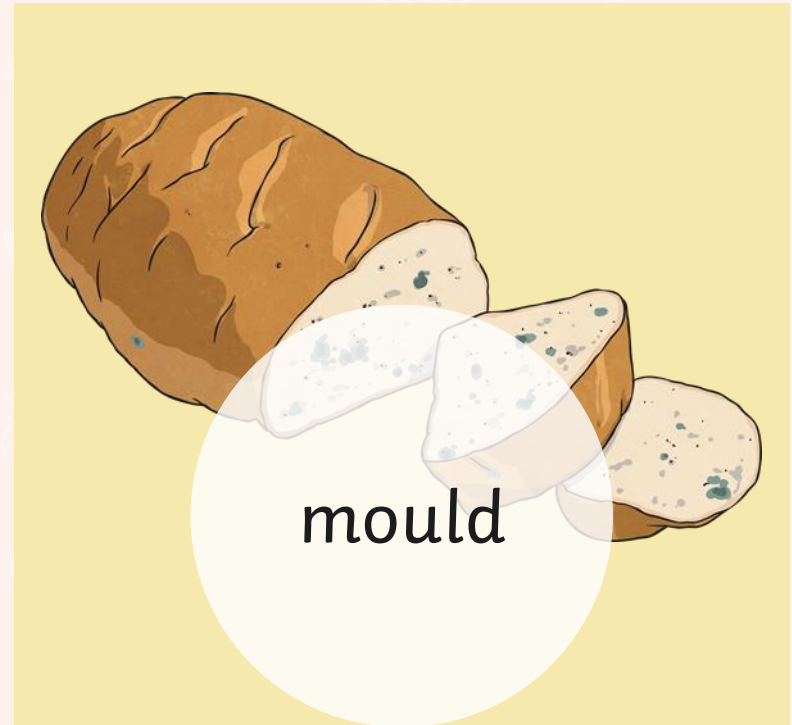


Words That Have a Long /o/ Sound Spelt Using 'ou' or 'ow'

We'll start by practising these challenge words by trying to help out Mr Whoops...

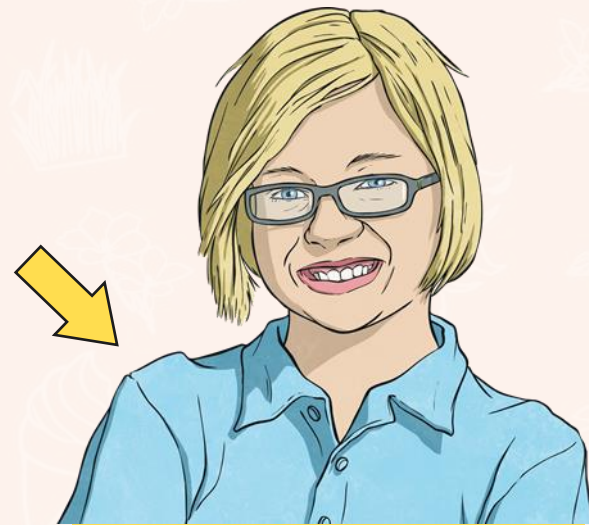
A joint at the top of your arm.

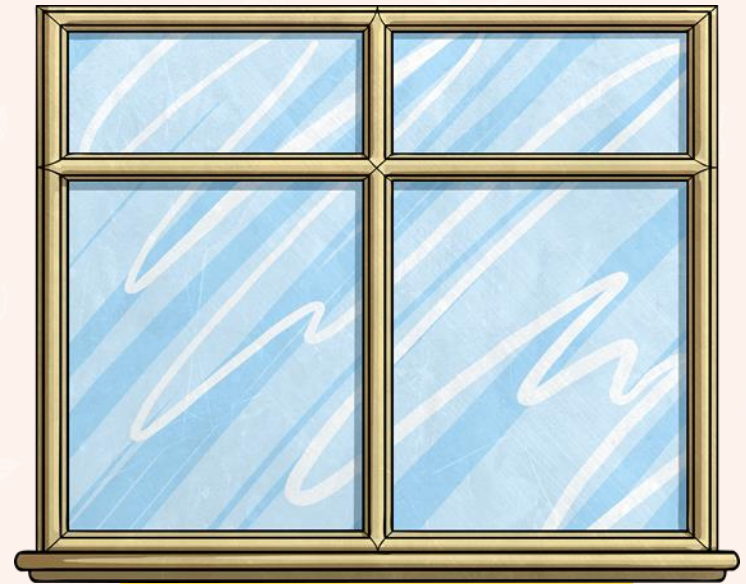

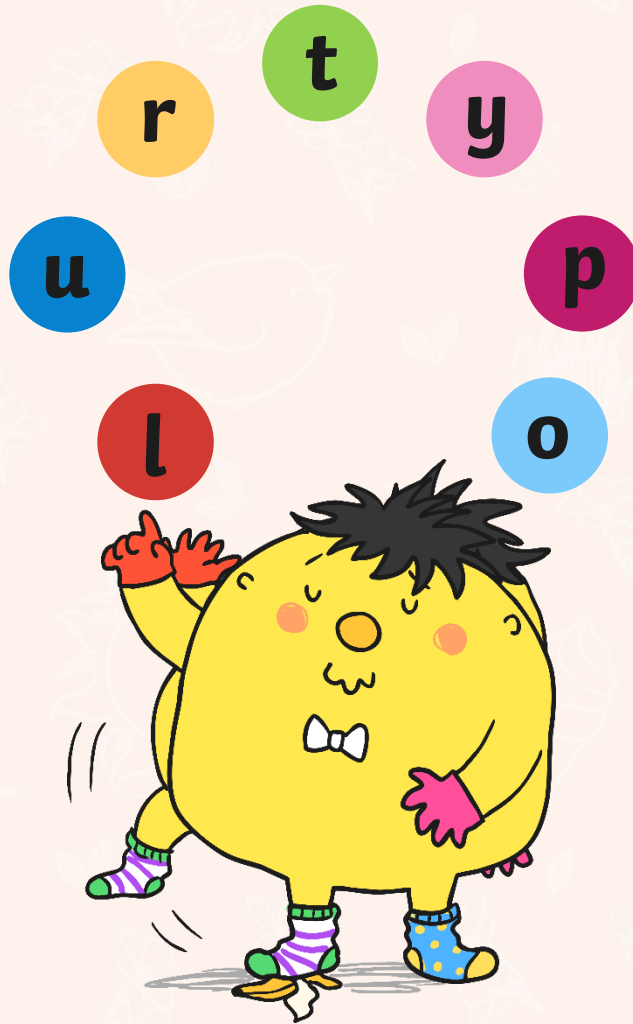

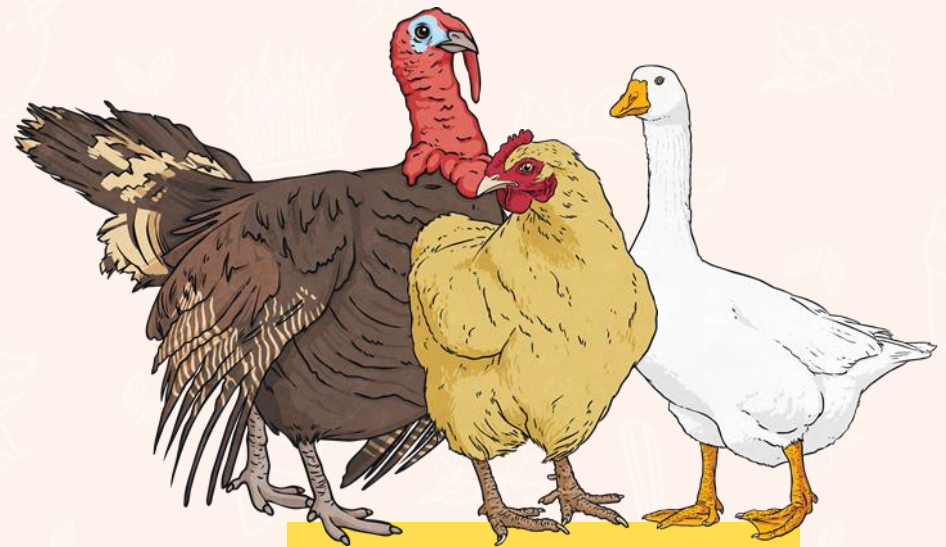
Domestic birds like chickens, turkeys and geese.
