Learning Objective

To correctly spell and use 'au' words.

For example:

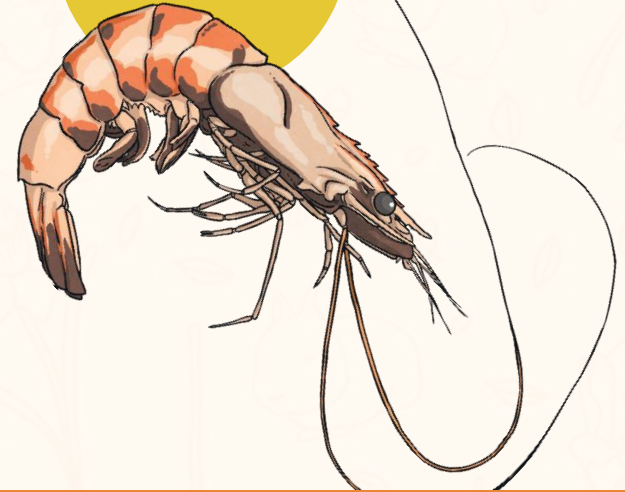
sport

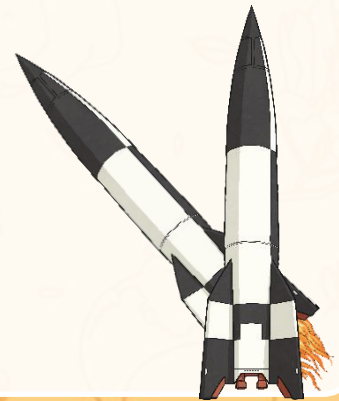
