Learning Objective To write your own fictional story using your unique characters.		
Success Criteria	Self-Assessment

<ul style="list-style-type: none">To ensure that you are including an opening paragraph, a main text including action/adventure, a potential problem, and a solution and a clear finishing paragraph ending the story.		
<ul style="list-style-type: none">To make sure that CL's, full stops and punctuation are consistent.		

I would like you to begin to write your own story using all of the materials you have created to help you so far (opening paragraph, character description, storyboard, new vocabulary). Your story should follow closely with the storyboard you created, but does not have to follow it exactly if you want to edit and improve your ideas.

You should include plenty of adjectives and exciting new words, you can even use a thesaurus to replace words you tend to repeat, such as said, good, bad, happy, sad.

You have today's and tomorrow's lesson to complete your story, so you do not need to rush. Today you may get your story opener done and a couple of paragraphs, and then continue with the rest tomorrow.
