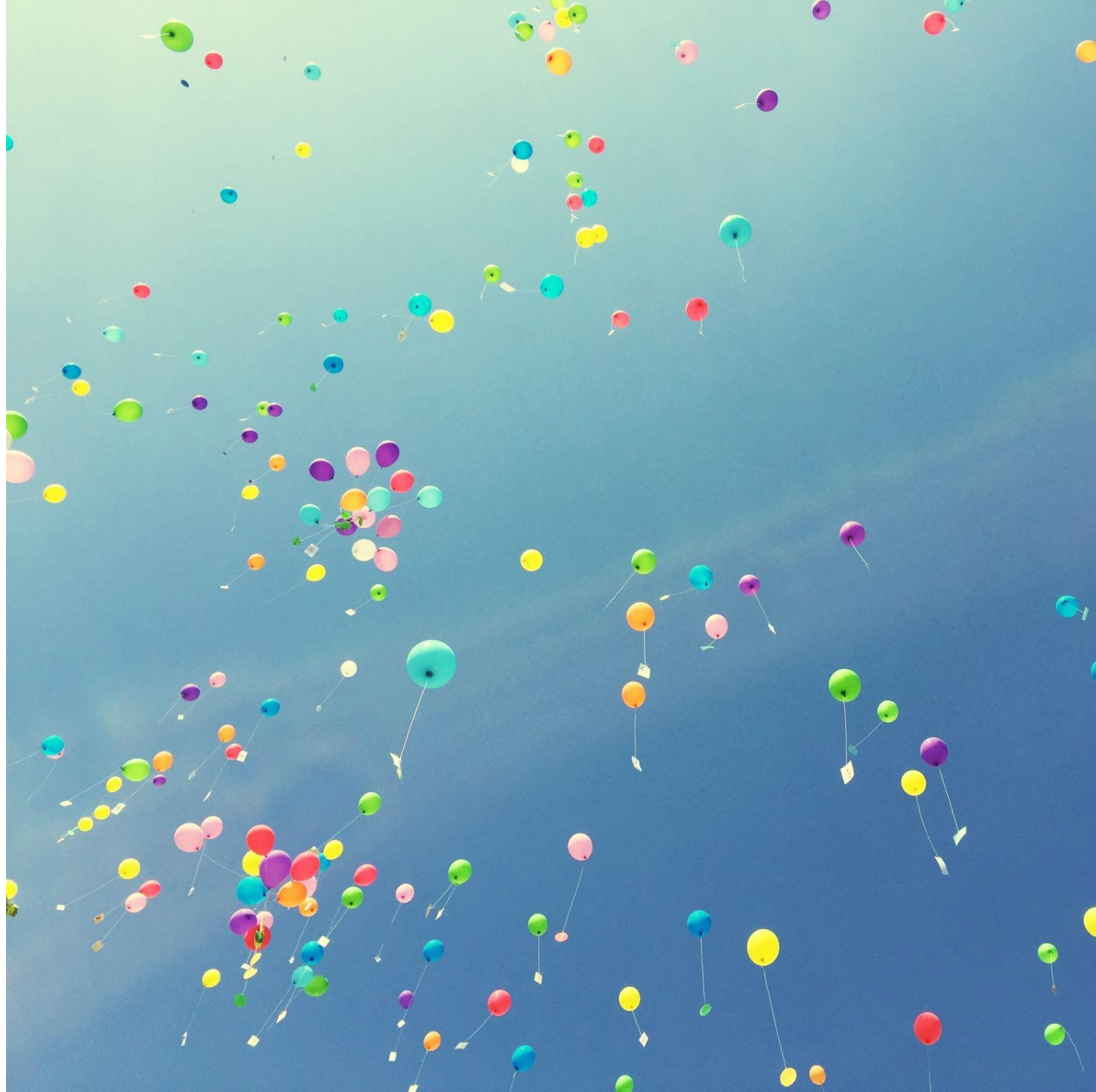

What is first person writing?

To write in first person you will mainly use the pronoun 'I'. You are telling the reader what happened from your own point of view. E.g. I went to... I enjoyed... I was with...

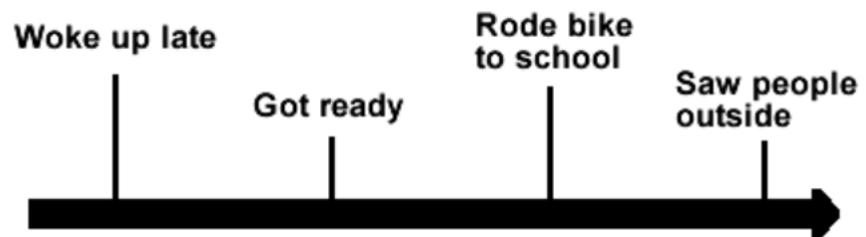

- *(the first person)*
a type of narrative in which the protagonist relates their story using the first person, i.e. using the pronoun 'I'.

What are time conjunctions?

First	Later	In due course
Next	In the end	At first
Just then	Finally	Until then
Meanwhile	After a while	After that
When	Immediately	In the mean time
Before long	Eventually	Once
	After some time
