The letters 'ough' within a word can sometimes make a different sound. For example, in the word through the ough sounds like 'oo'. In the word cough, the 'ough' sounds like 'off'. In the word dough, the 'ough' makes a longer 'o' sound.

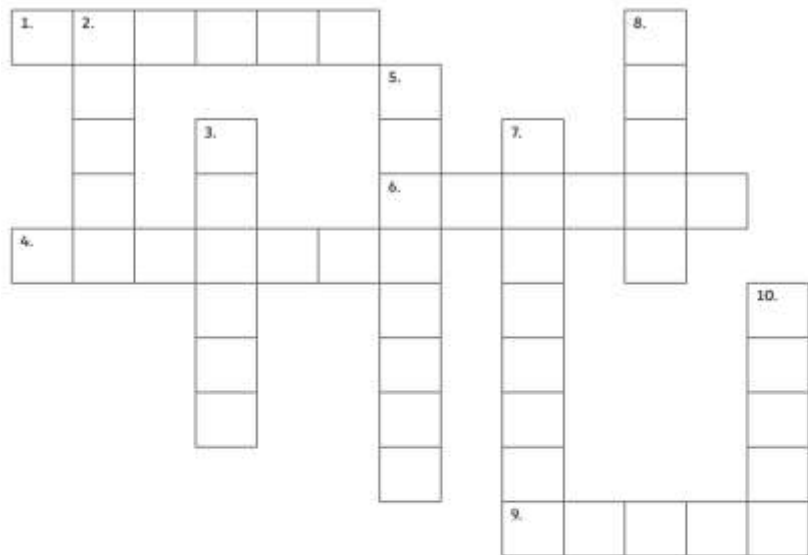
