

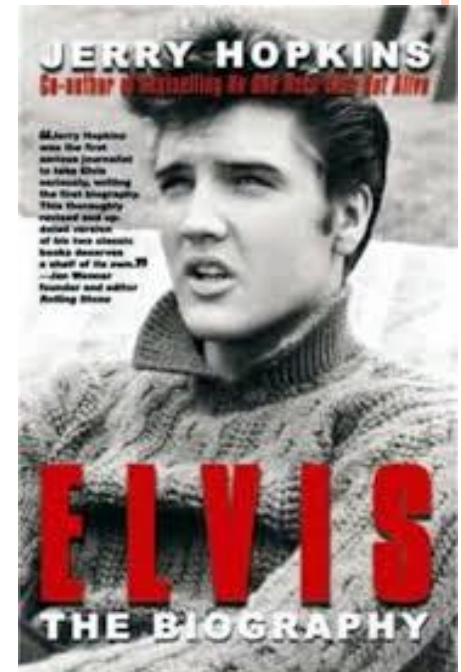
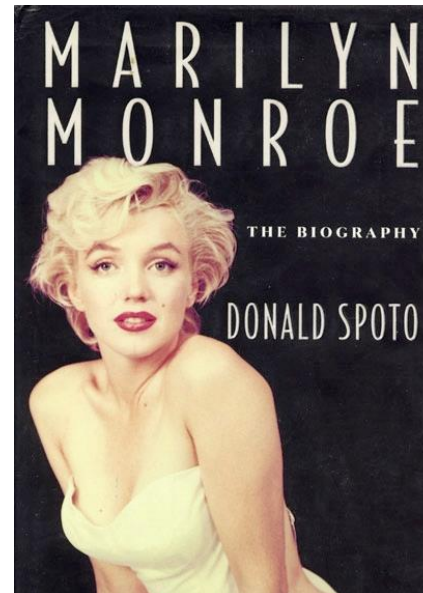
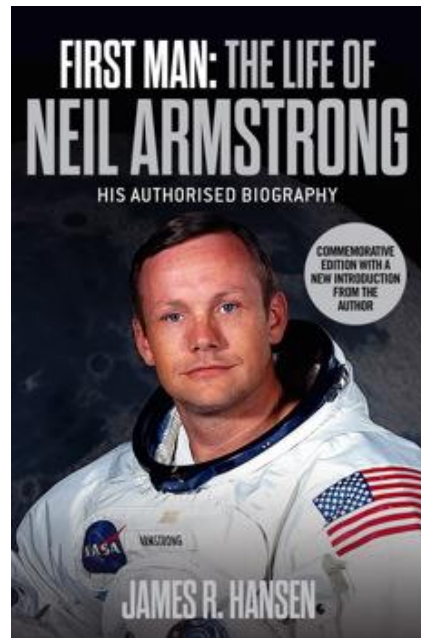
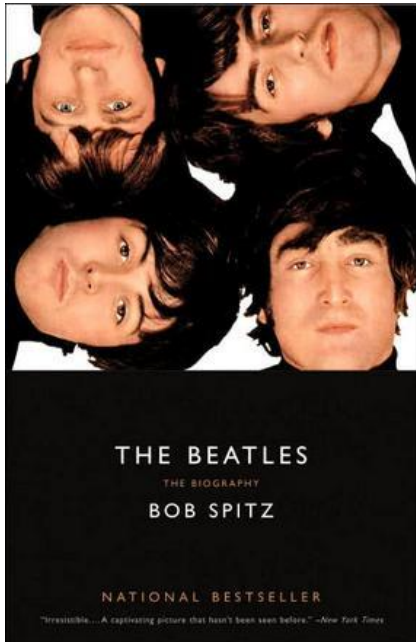
WRITING A BIOGRAPHY

WHAT IS A BIOGRAPHY?

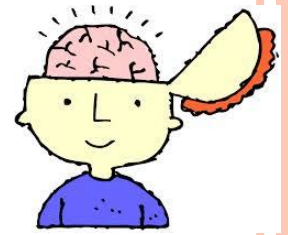
- Biographical writing is about someone else's life. It is about a real person but written by someone else.
- A biography highlights the key events that have happened in their life, sometimes talking about their childhood.
- A biography can be written about someone who is dead or alive.

FEATURES



- Title - name of biography
- Past tense
 - Third Person - he/she/they
 - Catchy Introduction - who/what/where/when/why
 - Paragraphs
 - Life events in chronological order of date
 - Time openers and conjunctions to show this
 - Quotes from others about what they think
 - Conclusion - how they will be remembered
